

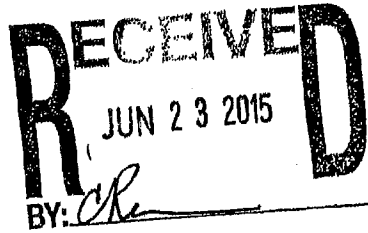

Please accept this, my application for the open, temporary, position on your governing board of directors. I am a resident of Banning, a US citizen in good health, with extensive experience in business management, as well as a university professor (details below) and have served on other boards of governors in the public and private domains. I'd welcome the opportunity to be interviewed and of course to have my background and credentials verified in the important process of selection.

Academic Background: BSc., Mechanical Engineering, Nene College, England. MBA and Ed.D. Pepperdine University, with post-doctoral studies in strategic management at The Wharton Graduate School, University of Pennsylvania, and at Cambridge University. Published more than fifty articles in academic journals and the general print media also three management books (and, incidentally, seven novels). Served as tenured Full Professor of Business and Endowed Chair at the University of Redlands for fifteen years (now Emeritus) and on numerous governance committees during my tenure there.

Business Background: Beginning as an engineer, fresh out of the British Army, I specialized in internal combustion engines with the (then) largest diesel engine manufacturer in the world, but transitioned rapidly into marketing and general/executive management with Fortune 500 Corporation Tenneco, Inc., was General Manager of operations, Canada, and Western Regional General Manager based in California. Tenneco, at that time, was the seventeenth largest corporation in the USA.

I am fully mindful of the important distinction between the work of professionals who operate and manage the day-to-day activities of an organization such as The Pass Water Agency and the roles & responsibilities of representation and oversight of board members. I make this statement because my background as an executive at high levels may create concerns about the potential for over-reach. The divide between the board and operational executives is real, and yet with mature cooperation and overall service to the community uppermost in the minds of all, a collegial relationship can exist and flourish. This is a letter of interest regarding the vacancy that has opened due to the passing of Ray Morris. I have a long history of public service in the Pass since my first election to the Banning City Council in 1986. I view water as our most critical issue and have taken every opportunity to learn more including taking tours of the Colorado River provided by the Metropolitan Water District and the Delta provided by your Agency.

My qualifications include a Master's in Public Administration from Cornell University's Graduate School of Business as well as almost 14 years of public service on the Banning City Council and 8 years employment by the City of Riverside. My resume is attached.

My years of service reflect my dedication to our residents. I have demonstrated my commitment to good public policy by my thorough study of the issues, my willingness to ask questions even when it is not popular and my professional rather than personality-driven conduct.

The long-term water plan that the Agency Board has developed requires that difficult decisions be made in very short order if the various local elected bodies' goal of increased residential development will be possible. The immediate drought and the long-term impact of climate reality create a critical situation. Banning, as an example, needs water development fees to develop its own water infrastructure as well as being able to afford to purchase water from the Agency. The Agency needs to impose development fees from those same new residents to purchase sustainable sources of water as well as further develop its infrastructure.

There is no way to responsibly avoid confronting these issues. We need an Agency Board that is willing to do so with transparency, authenticity, integrity and vision. I would appreciate becoming a part of such a Board of Directors.

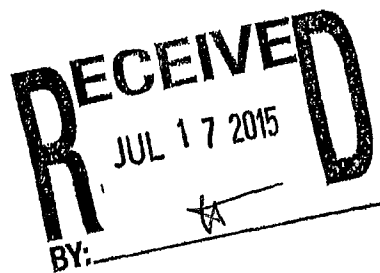

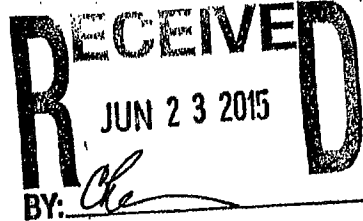

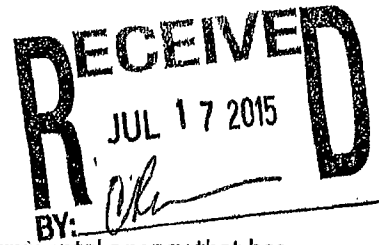
