- **A. General Manager's Report:** General Manager Eckhart reported that staff is working with retail water agencies on regional messaging for drought response.
- **B.** Legal Counsel's Report: Legal Counsel Ferre spoke on AB 1944. Mr. Ferre stated that this bill has a number of components including, but not limited to, requiring that the agenda identify any member of the legislative body that will participate in a meeting remotely. The bill would also require an updated agenda reflecting all of the members participating in the meeting remotely to be posted. In addition, a member would be exempt from identifying the address of the teleconference location, if the member elects to teleconference from a location that is not a public place.

6. New Business

A. San Gorgonio Flume Update (Art Vela (City of Banning, Director of Public Works) and Julie Hutchinson (Banning Heights Mutual Water Company))

Mr. Vela provided a slide presentation on the San Gorgonio Flume. He explained that the Flume was constructed over 100 years ago and started delivering water to the City of Banning and to BHMWC in 1913. The Flume is the primary source of water to the community of Banning Heights. Hydroelectric power generating capability was added in 1923. SCE and its predecessors are responsible for the operations and maintenance of the Flume. In 1998, SCE decided to surrender it's FERC License. Because of this, SCE is obligated to restore the Flume to working condition prior to transferring ownership to BHMWC and the City of Banning. Mr. Vela provided a historical overview of the restoration and the damage that the Apple Fire caused. Mrs. Hutchinson provided input on the current progress and the team effort it took to make a permanent fix to the Flume. Dale Hutchinson provided input on the construction aspect. The Board asked questions relating to the project. There was no public comment.

B. Agreement for State Water Project Multi-Year Transfer Program with City of Ventura and Notice of Exemption

Mr. Eckhart recognized Betsy Cooper (City of Ventura) who was in attendance at today's meeting. Mr. Eckhart provided a presentation that included charts on the Normal Year Supply vs Demand. The charts referenced additional proposed water storage, including SWP Table A water from the City of Ventura. He briefed the Board on the contents of the agreement. Public comment was received by General Manager Dan Jaggers (BCVWD) and Director Daniel Slawson (BCVWD). Director Smith made a motion to approve entering into the Agreement for Transfer of State Water Project Water with the City of Ventura and authorizing the filing of an associated Notice of Exemption. Director Duncan seconded the motion. Treasurer Letulle requested a roll call vote.
