B. Legal Counsel's Report: Mr. Ferre reviewed information on AB 2313. AB 2313 would authorize the Judicial Council to conduct institutes and seminars to orient judges to new judicial assignments related to the water industry. It would require the Judicial Council to identify experts in water science or management who may be available to a judge adjudicating an action relating to water.

A. State Water Project: Sustainability for the Pass Region

• Part 1 – State Water Project Overview

Sr. Planner Emmett Campbell provided a PowerPoint presentation on the State Water Project (SWP) that showed the transport path of the Agency's contracted amount of water (known as Table A) from Lake Oroville to the East Branch Extension. The presentation also included information about the SWP infrastructure. Joyce McIntire (YVWD Board member) and Paul Kielhold (SBVMWD Board member) made public comments.

7. New Business

A. Adopt Resolution No. 2022-19 Amending the Agency's Conflict of Interest Code (COI)

Legal Counsel Jeff Ferre informed the Board that the Agency's Conflict of Interest Code is a document that the Board reviews bi-annually. The COI identifies all Board Members and designated employees who may make decisions that would impact the Agency's financial interests. He recommended adoption of Resolution No. 2022-19, which would add the position of Sr. Water Resources Planner, and to confirm the description of the CFO and General Manager under part A, which are the officials managing public investments. President Smith requested Board comment on this proposal. Vice President Smith and Director Duncan commented and asked clarifying questions. Director Duncan made a motion to adopt Resolution No. 2022-19, adopting the amended Conflict of Interest Code of the San Gorgonio Pass Water Agency and directing that such amendment be submitted to the Fair Political Practices Commission as the Agency's code-reviewing body (Gov. Code § 87306 and 87306.5). Director Ball seconded the motion. President Smith requested a roll call vote.
