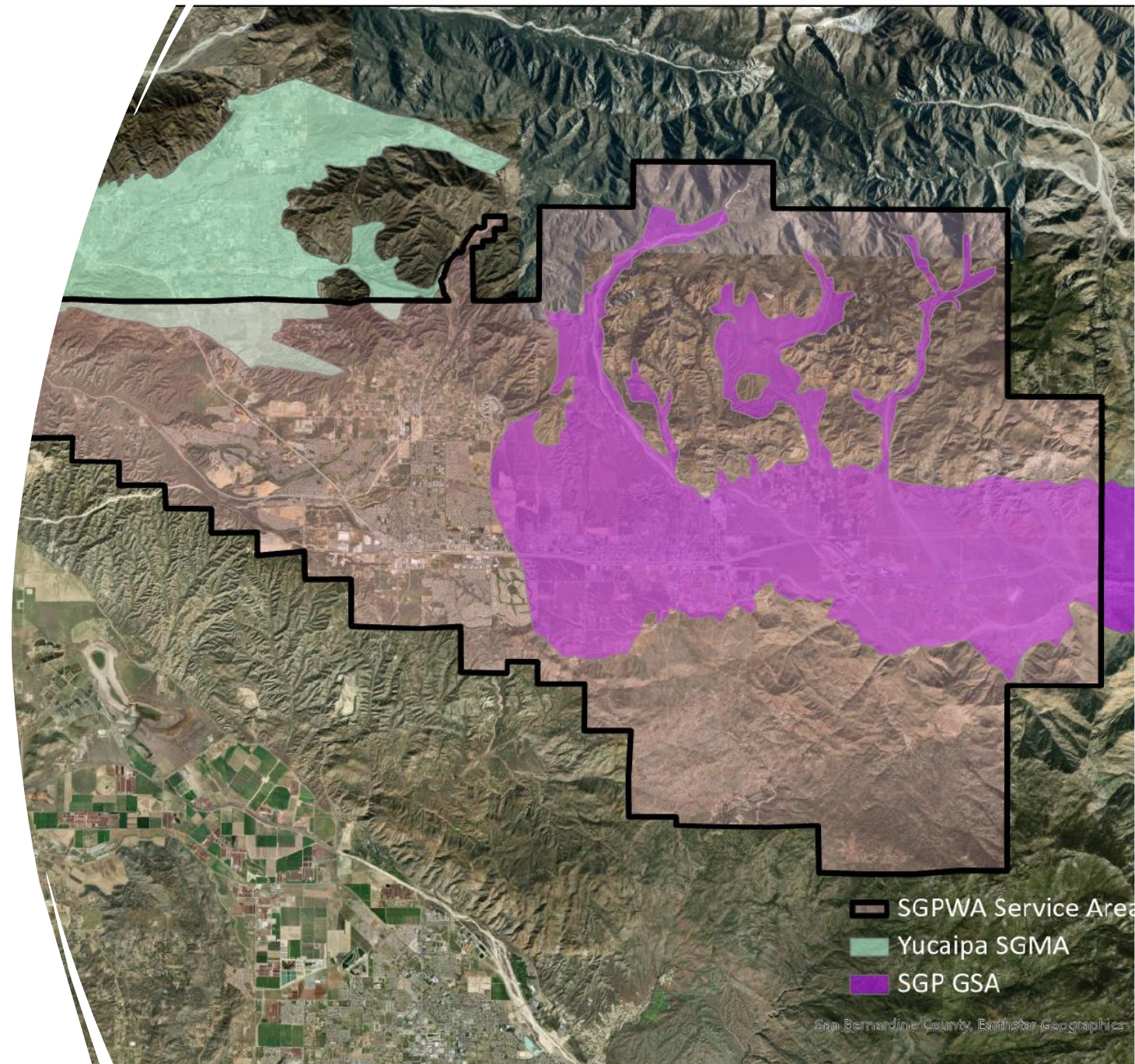

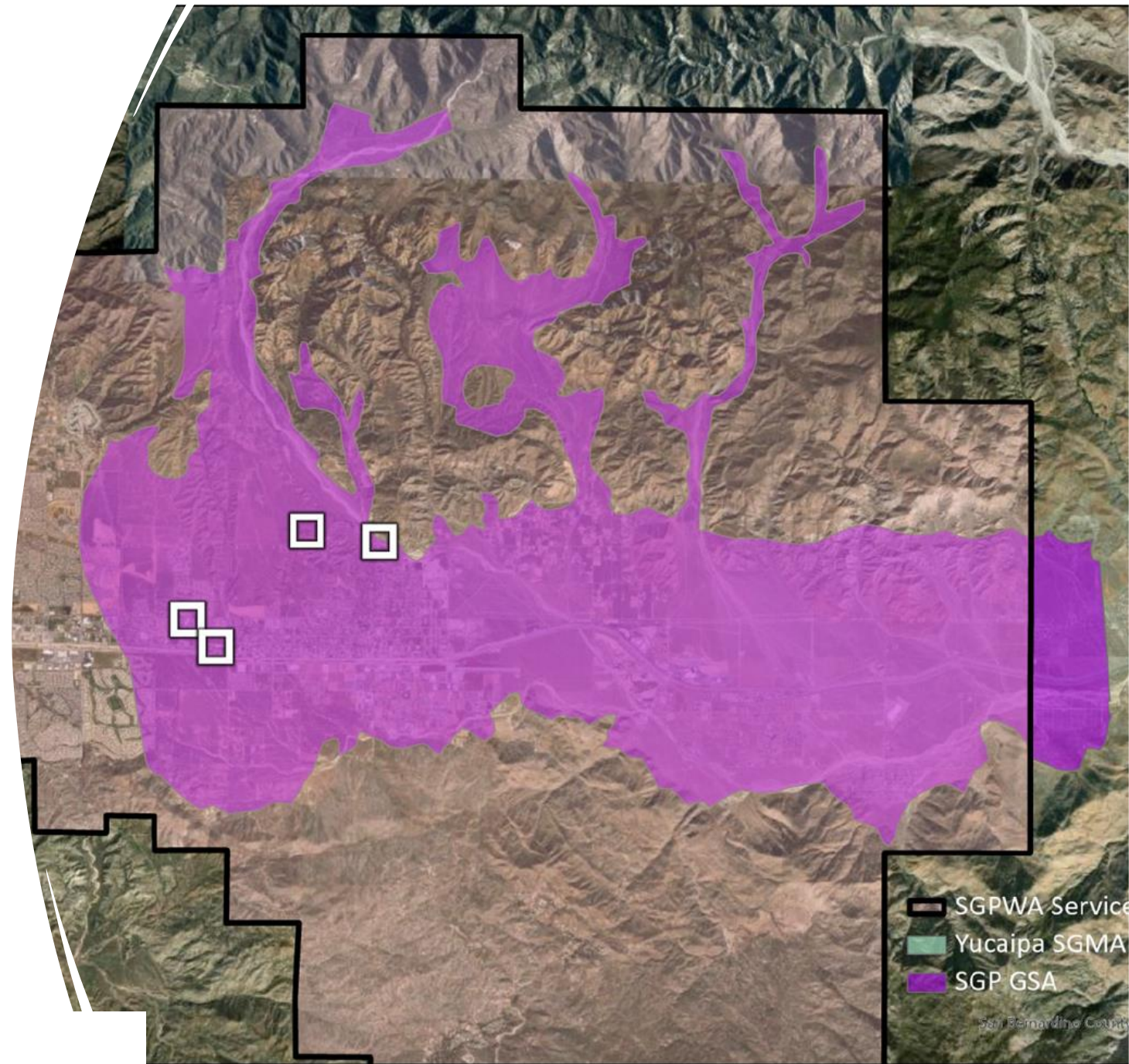
SGMA Implementation Grant Funding

- DWR's Sustainable Groundwater Management Grant Program's SGMA Implementation Round 2
 - High and Medium priority groundwater basins
 - Funding for implementation of projects, data gaps, and/or management actions
 - ~\$200M allocated for funding
 - \$1M - \$20M may be awarded to one basin



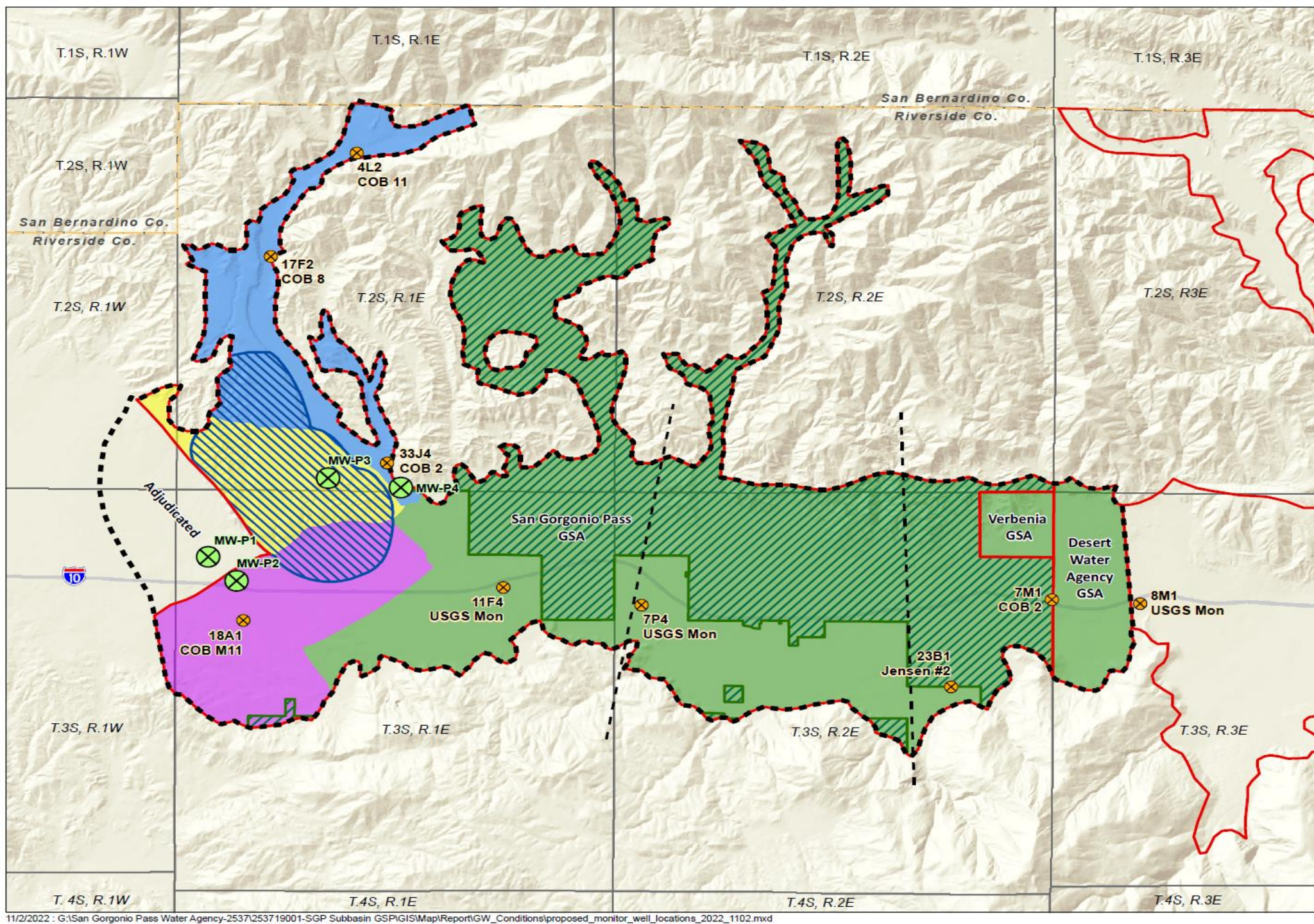
San Geronio Pass GSA

- Nested Monitoring Wells Project
 - Installation of four (4) nested casing monitoring wells to fill identified data gaps
- SGPWA will be the lead project proponent and grant application on behalf of GSA
- SGPWA Board adopted resolution 2022-29 authorizing the submission of the grant application to DWR
- Total Grant request: \$2,055,670



San Gorgonio Pass Subbasin

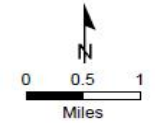
Data Gaps & Proposed Future Representative Water Level Monitoring Site Locations

- Proposed Future Monitoring Site Location

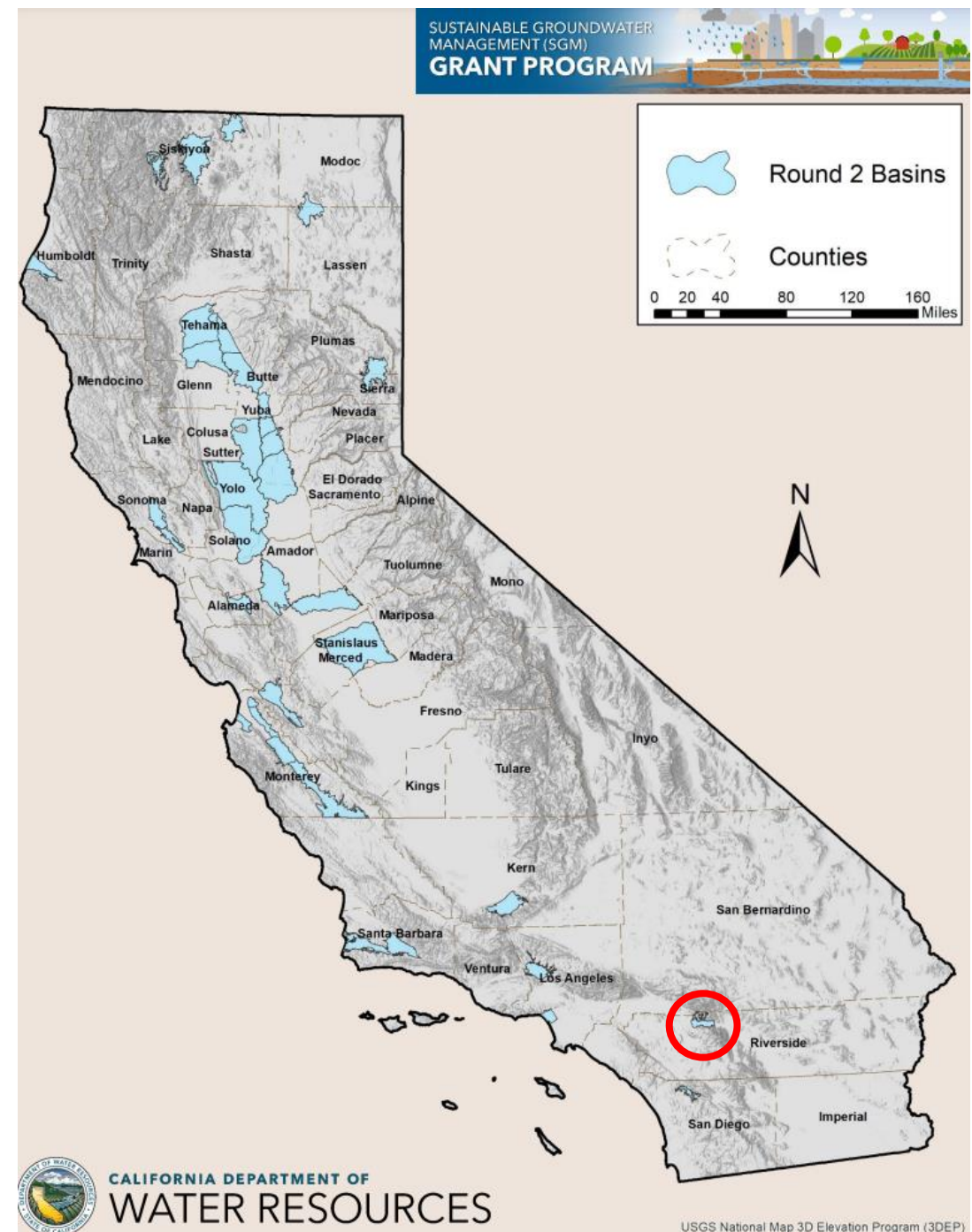

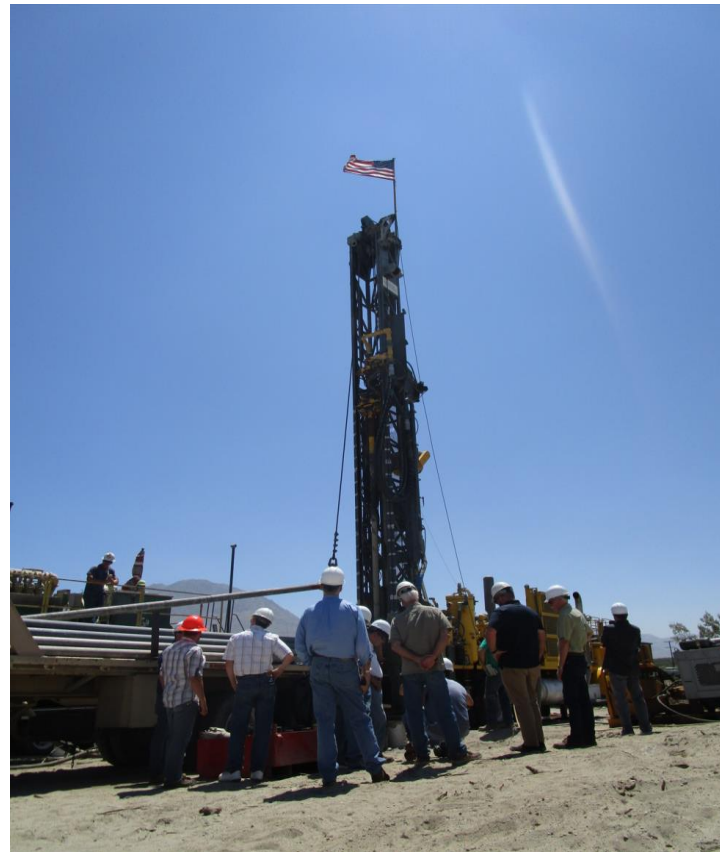


Preliminary Grant Awards

- San Geronio Pass Nested Monitoring Wells project awarded full grant request through DWR's SGMA Grant Program
- Total Grant Awarded: \$2,055,670
- DWR received 82 applications requesting over \$795 million in grant funds. The Draft Funding Recommendation will provide over \$187 million from SGMA and Proposition 68.

Next Steps

- Execute Grant Agreement with DWR (*pending final award*)
- Work with GSA to determine the Exact locations of the monitoring wells
- Coordinate with the USGS to drill these four nested monitoring wells
- Permitting and CEQA to start in Q3 of 2023
- Project completion anticipated in Q1 2025
