2. Adjustment and Adoption of Agenda

The agenda was adopted as published.

3. Public Comment

Public comment was provided by Matt Porras, Director of Engineering for the Yucaipa Valley Water District.

4. Consent Calendar

A. Approval of the Minutes of the Regular Board Meeting, September 11, 2023.

Mr. Walton moved, seconded by Mr. Letulle, to approve the consent calendar. President Smith requested a voice vote. The motion passed 7-0.

5. Reports

A. General Manager's Report

Mr. Eckhart reported on the following:

- 1. The Agency was notified of a Final Award from DWR in the amount of \$2 million. The grant funds will be used for nested monitoring wells in the Banning and Cabazon areas.
- 2. Staff is in the process of completing a WaterSmart Grant Application for the design of the Brookside West recharge facility. The application is due mid-October.
- 3. SBVMWD met last week with their stakeholders to discuss the Bunker Hill Basin banking program. More modeling work needs to be done.
- 4. The EBX easement near Danny Thomas Ranch is being reviewed by DWR. The process to complete it could be lengthy.
- 5. A Flume tour is not feasible at this time due to impassable road conditions caused by hurricane Hilary.

B. Legal Counsel's Report

Mr. Stewart reported that Best Best & Krieger staff are tracking several water-related bills that Governor Newsome is reviewing.

6. Informational Presentations and Updates

A. Water Conditions Update

Mr. Howard reviewed weather and reservoir conditions, SWP allocation, the SGPWA Water Portfolio, and SWP deliveries and recharge. Maintenance will be performed on the recharge ponds during the next two weeks.

B. Small Water Systems Program Update

Mr. Howard provided an update on the Small Water Systems Program. The Agency has contracted with California Rural Water Association to provide technical consulting to local small water systems within the Agency service area. A potential result of CRWA's efforts could be grant applications for assistance in infrastructure upgrades. A more detailed report will be presented at a future Board meeting.

C. Class 8 Overview and Water Management Analysis

Mr. Eckhart reviewed a list of State Water Contractors which divide them into general regional areas, called Classes. The Agency is a member of Class 8. The Agency has been involved in Class 8 meetings, with a goal of increasing collaboration and coordination. Under his signing authority, Mr. Eckhart has contracted with Provost & Pritchard to conduct a study for \$25,000 to identify potential banking opportunities and ways to leverage assets of the Class to enhance operational activities. The ten contractors will share the cost equally.
