






SWP Table A

Management Analysis Class 8 – Variety of Needs

Class 8 Contractors are trying to collaborate more and be unified

- Some have excess water
- Some have too little
- Some have groundwater storage
- Some rely on direct delivery
- Some have capacity constraints
- Some only need dry-year supplemental water
- Some actively bank locally, others use what they need

Management Analysis Class 8 – Water Mgmt. Analysis

Reconnaissance Level Scope (\$25,000)

- Timing and availability of SWP water
- Frequency and level of constraints
- Bottleneck analysis
- Upstream banking opportunities
- Groundwater & surface water storage
- Conveyance opportunities
- Optimized use of various assets within the Class 8 family
