5. Reports

A. General Manager's Report

Mr. Eckhart reported on the following:

1. Mr. Eckhart was a Panelist at the Public Policy Institute of California held on November 14th. President Smith, Mr. Valdivia, and David Armstrong (So. Mesa Water District) attended.

2. Deputy Director of the Division of Drinking was also in attendance. He and Mr. Eckhart discussed the Gap Funding Program started by the Agency. We will meet in January to discuss Gap Funding for other regions following the Agency's model.

3. The SAWPA Cloud Seeding Program unit located at the agency's Mountain View Turnout will be ignited on December 20th. Local authorities have been informed.

4. Up to 5,000 acre-feet of carry-over water from the City of Ventura agreement will be stored in San Luis Reservoir. This 3rd party agreement is unique to other agreements that DWR is accustomed to.

5. The Agency participated (via IERCD) in the city of Banning's Winter Wonderland Event that took place on December 16th.

6. The Vandalism Policy discussion will be on a future agenda.

7. Zoom disruption and hacking issues that have taken place at other entities. Staff is taking steps to mitigate any such issues at the Agency.

B. Legal Counsel's Report

Mr. Stewart said that DWR certified the Final Environmental Impact Report for the Delta Conveyance Project on December 8th. This action will start the CEQA process.

6. Informational Presentations and Updates

A. Property Tax Review 2023-24 and Forecast for 2024-25 (Paula Cone, HdL President)

Mr. Eckhart introduced Ms. Cone. Ms. Cone presented the 2023-2024 Property Data for the San Gorgonio Pass Water Agency and the Preliminary Special District Tax Reports. Ms. Cone answered questions. Mr. David Fenn (Beaumont City Councilman) provided public comment.

B. 2023 Retrospective

Mr. Eckhart reviewed the accomplishments and highlights of the Agency in 2023. Mr. Ybarra and President Smith thanked Mr. Eckhart for his efforts as the general manager.

C. Water Conditions Update

Mr. Howard stated that the Agency is five to six days away from reaching an alltime record of delivering 25,000 acre-feet. This includes storage through AVEK's banking program. The usual information about water conditions was included in the agenda packet. There was a short discussion on carry-over water.

7. New Business – Discussion and Possible Action

A. Strategic Plan 2023

Mr. Eckhart stated that the Strategic Plan has been discussed at length. He noted that this Plan is a living document that can be updated at the Board's pleasure, but at least every five years. He recommended that the Board consider adopting the 2023 Strategic Plan. Mr. Ybarra moved, seconded by Mr. Walton, to adopt the Strategic Plan – 2023. President Smith requested a roll call vote.
