

PROGRAM


We are a system of systems aligned in a common objective.

A continuous planning assessment to maintain water supply reliability over a 50-year planning horizon:

- 1. Potential acquisition of future supplies; leveraging existing portfolio; maximizing value.
- 2. SGPWA activities, e.g. external water leases, local and external banking, statewide projects – Sites/DCP/VA's, actively buying/selling water, conservation/education.
- **3.** Retailer activities, e.g., local banking, conservation, recycled water, collaborative projects.
- **4.** The importance of regional collaboration.






LESSONS LEARNED



Regulatory Uncertainty: BAY-DELTA PLAN

- Establishes water quality objectives to protect beneficial uses of Bay-Delta water
- Requires increases in unimpaired flows from both Sacramento and San Joaquin River (SJR) watershed (45-65%)
- Plan amendments adopted in 2018 by State Board for southern Delta (SJR)
- Sacramento River watershed amendments expected in 2024
- SWP implications: potential for lower allocations, stranded assets, local regulatory burden


