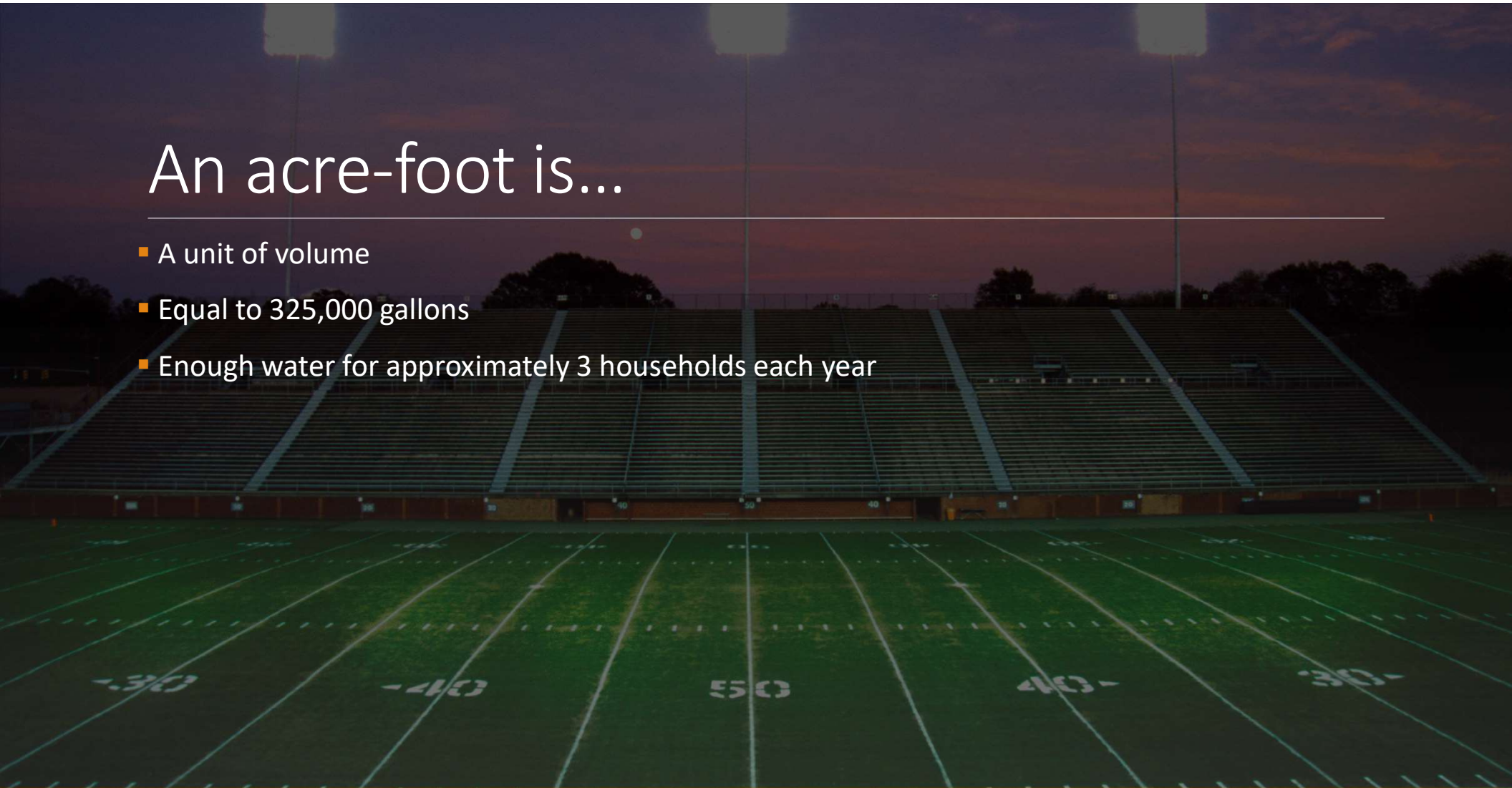

An acre-foot is...

- A unit of volume
- Equal to 325,000 gallons
- Enough water for approximately 3 households each year

Water Supply Contract

- SGPWA/DWR executed in 1962
- Allowed for SGPWA to participate in the State Water Project
- Outlined terms and conditions of participation
- Apportioned the project costs among contractors
- Allowed DWR to build the California Aqueduct
- Outlines multiple types of water
- Outlines the process to transfer or exchange water
- Has been amended 21 times since 1962

SGPWA's Water Supply Contract Profile:



About 0.4% of the total State Water Project



This translates into 17,300 acre-feet of the total 4,100,000 acre-feet in the State Water Project



Participates in 500 miles of infrastructure

The Water Supply Contract outlines multiple types of water including...

| | |
|------------------|---|
| Table A Water | Entitlement water that DWR provides to the Agency annually |
| Carryover Water | Last years unused Table A that can be stored in San Luis Reservoir |
| Article 21 Water | Surplus water that is made available to State Water Project contractors on a short-term basis when excess flows exist in the system |
| Article 55 Water | Contractors can utilize State Water Project facilities to move non-State Water Project to their respective service areas |
